Former QR 2819 that was converted to standard gauge and saw use on QR National intermodal services interstate has been converted back to narrow gauge at UGR Bassendean together with modifications to suit it operating on ARG in WA. 2819 has been classified PA but retains its old QR number now being PA2819 and has been repainted into ARG [QR] yellow livery was outside erecting shed at UGR on April 10th.

JRA6 former Overlander sleeping car that was converted into a crew car for Australia Southern Railroad and its last use has been on now very irregular Cook fuel train operated out of Kalgoorlie. This fuel train with the two vans of supplies for the big pastoral leases at Naretha and Rawlinna last ran out of Kalgoorlie to Cook on March 4th. With the operation of this fuel train out of Kalgoorlie now appearing to be very uncertain with it likely to remain running out of Forrestfield on QR National intermodal services. JRA6 could be better utilised operating for G&WA in SA so it was hauled to Forrestfield on 5426 freight on April 2nd then hauled to SA on 7PA1 QRN intermodal on 3rd.

Three QRN 6000s ran on QRN intermodal 3PA1 on March 30th, then two 6000s ran the intermodal service on April 3rd, 6th and 10th in what appears will now be the regular motive power for this train.

The final Indian Pacific passenger service of Summer Season to arrive in Perth on Saturday and return interstate on Sunday arrived on March 27th hauled by NR27 that also ran the return service on 28th. Twice weekly Indian Pacific services between Sydney and Perth will resume for the Spring Wildflower Season with departure from Sydney on August 31st that will continue till final twice weekly service departs Perth on November 28th.

Long awaited naming process of BHP Billiton Iron Ore SD70MACe units has commenced with 4341 being out-shopped on April 9th named "Oroville". It is probably coincidence but the naming of first of these locomotives after where original car dumper and ore cars were obtained by then Mt Newman Mining does have historic significance. These name plates are not cast plaques as are applied to all previously named locomotives in BHPBIO fleet but is a stainless steel plate with black lettering mounted on cab side below window sill above the road number. While 4331 had the name "Withnell" applied on April 10th.
