Eight Robe River Iron Associates CM40-8M locomotives many of them were withdrawn in May June 2009 following the arrival of further ES44DCi locomotives have been offered for sale by tender. The locomotives 9410, 9414, 9417, 9420, 9421, 9423 and 9425 are in Robe River yellow livery while 9424 is in yellow and grey Pilbara Iron livery. These locomotives together with Hamersley Iron CM36-7M 5051 and 5052 that were originally Mt Newman Mining 5507 and 5508 are located in Dampier inspection by appointment only. Ross's Auctioneers and Valuers are offering these locomotives on behalf of Rio Tinto with tenders closing 1700 WST August 6th. 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BHPBIO SD70ACe #4323 has been named Courage and #4352 named Lightning.

Nickel kibbles on flattops traffic that was hauled to Esperance on 443 freight train for export, has gone over to road transport with the fuel from Shell terminal Esperance being the only traffic now on the freight service. It's believed this fuel cartage will originate from BP Kewdale terminal in mid next year with West Kalgoorlie Esperance line only traffic then iron ore trains. The freight between West Kalgoorlie and Leonora of fuel and lead concentrate will continue to operate.

SD40s continue to run on BHPIO ore trains occasionally while those transferred to ADP regularly run work trains in and out of Bing yard.
