Following the sale of South Spur Rail to POTA operation of a second tier small third operator in this state ended as the few remaining infrastructure contacts wound down. Greentrains now own what was the South Spur Rail locomotive fleet with it stabled/stored in the old SSRS yard at Bellevue. K210, D48, D49 and D51 together with D47 that only ever hauled one service in WA before failing are not seeing use. On the narrow gauge R1902, KA212, ZB2120, ZB2125 and ZB2129 are in the same compound with Indonesian built GE U20C U201 that has never seen mainline use. Stored in Port Hedland are DR8401, DR 8402, DR8403 and DR8404 rebuilt C636Rs lettered FMG in blue and white livery. DR8405 in Greentrains livery that has never seen use and incomplete DR8406 are stored in Engenco yard Maddington. Only K205 and K206 are in use operating ballast trains on the Karara line in the Mid West. All the locomotives at old SSRS yard Bellevue are fully operational being started regularly and are available for use. These locomotives except U201 are English Electric models built in Rocklea Qld being incompatible with EMD, Alco or GE units.

8112 returned interstate on 7PX4 on October 1st following return of yard shunter 8039 after maintenance.

2011 sees the 20th anniversary of electric trains running to the Royal Show at Claremont it commenced on September 28th 1991 and was their first revenue use. All services on Midland Fremantle line are four car sets supplemented with some B series cars on show specials from October 1st to 8th.

DC2213 former Forrestfield workshop shunter has been repainted into QRN livery as part of its overhaul but is yet to return to service.

ACB4404 ran its light engine train with ACB4403 Chullora to Penrith NSW on October 6th.

025 Forrestfield Kalgoorlie and 426 Kalgoorlie Forrestfield freight are now worked with Q class AC class combinations, multiple Q class or even multiple AC class locomotives. L, LZ or LQ class have only worked this service once in last few weeks. ALZ3208 often remote unit on this train has not run on it in recently.

Following tier three lines will open for forthcoming 2011/2012 grain harvest; West Merredin to Trayning that will need considerable work done in Trayning yard to repair flood damage sustained earlier in the year, West Merredin to Bruce Rock, Bruce Rock to Yilliminning, York to Quairading. These lines will be open till October 2012 when will close but be on care and maintenance as upgraded area roads will then be able to handle road trains transporting grain.

DPU iron ore trains have ramped up with all trains in late September early October having, two locomotives 63 cars then one locomotive and 63 cars. Further DPU trial took place on October 3rd with 2416 empty was AC4308 and 42 wagons, Q4014and 42 wagons, Q4005 and 42 wagons with 3413 loaded from the mine being same configuration. This trail was conducted as it's believed some communication issues were experienced on earlier locomotive 53 wagons, locomotive 53 wagons and locomotive 20 wagons trial. DPU operations on Esperance Koolyanobbing ore trains were again suspended on October 5th after it's believed the brakes on rear portion of 3417 loaded unexpectedly releasing. All DPU operations have been suspended till this incident is fully investigated.
